Orland-Oslo Route:

- All-year-round route, partly subsidized by the Norway Military
- 9 weekly rotations
- Last year: 23,000 flown sold seats; this year: expecting 24,500
- Mix of Military (33%) and leisure and other types of travelers (67%)

Orland-Evenes Route:

- All-year-round route, partly subsidized by the Norway Military
- 2 weekly rotations
- Last year: 3,000 flown sold seats; this year: expecting 3,300
- Mix of Military (60%) and leisure and other types of travelers (40%)
